- 1 Child's Hall also known as Childshall
- 2 Transferred from 1st portion
- 3 Transferred from 2nd portion
- 4 Also known as John ap Rees ap Griffith & possibly as John Aprice
- 5 Possibly 1597; the same person as Owen Davies of 2nd portion; also reported as being Rector of 1st portion in 1612
- 6 Transferred from 1st portion
- 7 Transferred from 3rd portion & possibly back to 3rd portion in 1660
- 8 Transferred from 3rd portion
- 9 Probably a different spelling of Cherlton
- 10 Same as William de Aston in 2nd portion in 1321
- 11 Possibly same name as Rodene or Roden
- 12 First and Second portions were united in 1909
